**Description of State Maintenance lines established for
delimiting the urban area of**

BERWICK, YORK COUNTY, MAINE

Beginning at a point in the Salmon Falls River at the end of Rochester Street and on the northeast side of Bridge #6048, thence southeasterly along the northerly right-of-way of Rochester Street to the intersection of Hubbard Road, thence southeasterly to the intersection of Pine Hill Road and Sullivan Street, thence southeasterly to the intersection of Logan Street and School Street (Route 9), thence northeasterly along the northerly right-of-way of School Street (Route 9) to the intersection of Old Pine Hill Road N, thence across School Street (Route 9), thence southeasterly along the easterly right-of-way of Old Pine Hill Road S to the intersection of Berwick Road, thence southeasterly along the northerly right-of-way of Berwick Road to the intersection of Route 236, thence southeast along the northerly right-of-way of Route 236 to the intersection of New Dam Road, thence across Route 236, thence northwest along the southerly right-of-way of Route 236 to the point of intersection of Sawmill Hill, thence along the southerly right-of-way of Sawmill Hill and Route 9 to the town line in the Salmon Falls River at Bridge #2068, thence along the town line in the Salmon Falls River to the point of beginning.

NOTE: Bridges, if any, bisected by the State Maintenance Line are in the rural area.
