THE OWNER HEREBY AGREES TO:

- (1) Provide, erect and maintain all necessary barricades, lights, warning signs and other devices to safeguard traffic properly while the work is in progress.
- (2) At no time cause the highway to be closed to traffic.
- (3) Where the driveway/entrance is located within a curb, curb and gutter, and/or sidewalk section, completely remove the existing curb, curb and gutter, and/or sidewalk as may be required to create the driveway/entrance and restore drainage. All driveways/entrances abutting sidewalk sections shall meet the requirements set forth in the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. §§ 12132 et seq.
- (4) Obtain, deliver to site and install any culverts and/or drainage structures necessary for drainage; the size, type and length of such culverts or structures shall be as specified in the permit pursuant to 23 M.R.S.A. § 705.
- (5) Complete construction of proposed driveway/entrance within twelve months of commencement of construction.
- (6) Comply with all applicable federal, state, and municipal regulations and ordinances.
- (7) Not alter, without the express written consent of MaineDOT, any culverts or drainage swales within MaineDOT's right-of-way.
- (8) File a copy of the approved driveway/entrance permit with the affected municipality or LURC, as appropriate, within 5 business days of receiving MaineDOT approval; and mail a copy of the approved driveway/entrance permit to the immediate abutters within 5 business days of receiving the MaineDOT approval.
- (9) Shall construct and maintain the entrance side slopes to be no steeper than the adjacent roadway side slopes, but in no case to be steeper than 3 horizontal to 1 vertical, unless the side slope is behind existing roadway guardrail, in which case it shall be no steeper than 2 horizontal to 1 vertical.
- (10)Notify MaineDOT of a proposed change of use served by driveway/entrance when an increase in traffic flow is expected to occur.
