The Department requires nonresidents who own a minimum of 25 acres in Maine to complete this document in order to legally hunt on resident's only day for deer.

Any nonresident hunter who meets the requirements established in 12 M.R.S. § 11401, sub-§1, Paragraph "E" (below) and who hunts on the Saturday preceding the first day of the open season on deer (known as Maine Resident Day) must carry on their person, this completed form. This document must be provided to the Commissioner or the Commissioner's agent upon their request. This document shall also be used for verification purposes by the hunter when registering a deer killed on this day. If there are multiple landowners for the same land each hunter shall have a separate and completed form. This form **MUST** be fully completed to be valid.

MAINE STATE LAW 12 MRSA §11401, sub-§1, Paragraph "E"

E. A nonresident who owns 25 or more acres of land in the State and leaves that property open to hunting, holds a valid hunting license and is not otherwise prohibited by law may hunt deer on the Saturday preceding the first day of open season on deer.

By signing this statement, the landowner verifies that the representations and facts herein are true. By making false statements on this document, I realize that I am committing a Class D crime, punishable by law under MRSA, Title 17-A, §453.
