General

Can school and SAU personnel still access prior assessment scores on the FocalPoint K12 site?

Maine's Accountability and Assessment Reporting System (MAARS), for which the vendor was FocalPoint K12, was sunset in early summer 2023.

At this time, the Maine DOE Data Team is creating a "data lake" that will store the assessment information previously available in MAARS and make that data available to SAUs. We do not yet have a timeline for the availability of the new data lake.

Question

Is there a negative to rostering by grade level, specifically rostering all students in a grade level to one class (i.e., proctor group)?

You can certainly place all students in a grade level in a single class, or proctor group. Multiple proctors can log in to the same proctor group over multiple days, so that will not impact the administration of the assessment.

If there are many students in the grade level, however, you may want to consider the ease of access, for example the need to scroll through a long list of students to monitor progress, reseal a student, or enable text-to-speech.
