We have reviewed the proposed shellfish license allocation for 2024, and hereby approve them as follows:

The required 10% rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than 10% if desired.

Recreational	Other- Conservation credit	5	\$0

Licenses may be issued starting on November 28, 2023, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.
