2. Update on Transition and Inaugural Committees

The Commission will receive an update on the financial disclosure statements and fundraising by the transition and inaugural committees of Gov. Janet T. Mills.

3. Maine Clean Election Act Violation – Stephen C. Ball

In 2018, Stephen C. Ball participated in the Maine Clean Election Act (MCEA) program as a candidate for the Maine House of Representatives. MCEA candidates are not permitted to spend personal funds for campaign expenditures. The candidate used \$393.96 of his own money to pay for decals to insert the required “paid for and authorized by” information on his signs. *Staff recommendation: the Commission staff recommends finding that the candidate’s expenditure of personal funds violated 21-A M.R.S.A. § 1125(6) and assessing a penalty of \$100.*

4. Update on Audits of 2018 Maine Clean Election Act Candidates

The Commission’s auditors will update the Commission on the progress of the post-election audit of 2018 Maine Clean Election Act candidates.
