Douglas Pond is a headwater to Kibby Stream north of the Kibby Mountain Range. Its outlet, the East Branch of Kibby Stream, flows southwest into Kibby Stream. The shoreline is undeveloped.

Douglas Pond is a shallow pond with a silt-covered bottom. No fish species were taken during the survey and it is unlikely that coldwater gamefish could survive in such a shallow pond.


Douglas Pond is accessible via gravel logging roads off the Gold Brook Road from Route 27.
