
Principal Fishery: Brook trout

Fourth Pond is a shallow, warmwater pond located just south of the Kingdom Road in Blue Hill. About a 1/4-mile walk is required to reach the pond. A few native trout enter the pond from the inlet, but the fishery is reported to be limited in nature.

Due to the limitations of water quality and the presence of competing fish species, no stocking of coldwater gamefish is recommended.
