Trout Pond is a small, scenic pond located off the Saponac-Beddington road. A short stretch of jeep road leads directly to the pond. There are no beaches of any sort.

There is a sufficient body of cold well-oxygenated water for trout, although an oxygen deficiency does exist beneath the 20-foot level. The outlet has no spawning or nursery area. Periodic stocking with fall fingerlings is carried out to maintain the trout fishery.


The following regulations are in effect to insure maximum benefits from the fishery:

1. Closed to ice fishing
2. Use or possession of live fish as bait is prohibited
3. Five fish daily limit.
