Access is via private gravel roads built and maintained by industrial landowners for forest management purposes. Watercraft may be launched via an unimproved site from the gravel road adjacent the southeast shore of the pond.


Allagash Pond is a small shallow pond bordered by a forested shoreline. Development is limited to a single private camp on the north end. Spring influence keeps the water sufficiently cool to support a wild brook trout population. However an abundant population of white suckers keeps trout numbers low by competing for food and space. Trout reproduction appears to occur primarily within the pond.

Conservative fishing regulations have been established to protect the wild trout population.
