Suggested Management


Wadleigh Pond has a large volume of water suitable for cold-water game fishes. An oxygen deficiency exists below 30 feet.

This pond supports a population of the rare blueback trout, apparently living in harmony with a population of brook trout. Two species of minnows are present in small numbers.

To distribute the catch and prevent the introduction of undesirable species the following regulations have been established:

1. Five trout daily bag limit.
2. Closure to ice fishing.
3. Use or possession of live fish as bait prohibited.

The outlet can be improved by removing inactive beaver dams, by removing debris from past lumbering operations, and by confining the stream to one channel.
