

## PISCATAQUIS COUNTY

### **Allagash Wilderness Waterway**

#### **A.** The following Allagash Wilderness

Waterway waters in Piscataquis County are open to ice fishing with the special rule(s) indicated after each - see pages 7 and 44. ALL OTHER AWW WATERS ARE CLOSED TO ICE FISHING.

#### **Allagash Lake, T7&8R14 WELS.**

Open to fishing for all fish during the month of February only. S-4, S-8 (except that 5 lines may be used from sunset to sunrise while fishing for cusk), S-16. Minimum length limit on whitefish: 16 inches. The use of motorized equipment is prohibited.

#### **Chamberlain Lake, including Round Pond and Telos Lake, T5&6R11**

WELS, T6&7R12 WELS, T7&8R13 WELS. B. S-21. Minimum length limit on whitefish: 16 inches.

Closed area: that portion from the mouth of Allagash Stream out to a straight line between two red markers, one set on the southwest shore near the Upper Crows Nest campsite, the other set on the northeast shore at the intersection of the T7R13/T8R13 township line with the lakeshore.

**Churchill Lake (including Heron Lake), T9&10R12 WELS, T9R13 WELS.** B. S-16. Closed to taking whitefish.

#### **Eagle Lake (including Round Pond), T7,8&9R13 WELS, T7&8R12 WELS.**

B. S-16. Closed to taking whitefish.

#### **B.** The following Allagash Wilderness

Waterway waters in Piscataquis County are open to open water fishing with the special rule(s) indicated after each - see page 7.

**Allagash Lake, T7&8R14 WELS.** Only artificial lures with one hook - a single-pointed hook or a treble hook - allowed. S-16. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches.

#### **Allagash Stream (inlet to Allagash Lake) upstream from Allagash Lake to the T8R15 township line (AWW boundary), T8R14 WELS.**

Only artificial lures with one hook - a single-pointed hook or a treble hook - allowed. S-16. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches. From August 16 - September 30: Only artificial lures with one hook - a single-pointed hook or a treble hook - allowed. Minimum length limit on trout: 12 inches. Total daily bag limit on trout and togue: 1 fish. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches.

#### **Allagash Stream (outlet of Allagash Lake) from Allagash Lake**

#### **downstream to Little Round Pond, T8**

R13&14 WELS. S-6, S-16. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches. From August 16 - September 30: S-6.

Minimum length limit on trout: 12 inches. Total daily bag limit on trout and togue: 1 fish. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches.

#### **Allagash Stream from Little Round Pond downstream to the red markers**

**at the trestle on Chamberlain Lake, T8R13 WELS.** S-6, S-21. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches. From August 16 - September 30: Closed to all fishing.

**Allagash River, from Churchill Dam** downstream to the red markers at the confluence of Chisolm Brook, T10R12 WELS. S-6, S-16, S-25. From August 16 - September 30: S-6.

Minimum length limit on trout: 12 inches. Total daily bag limit on trout and togue: 1 fish. Please refer to law regarding fishways on page 9.

#### **Chamberlain Lake, including Round Pond and Telos Lake, and their tributaries (except Allagash Stream),**

upstream to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway blazed line, T5&6R11 WELS,

T6&7R12 WELS, T7&8R13 WELS, etc. S-21. Minimum length limit on whitefish: 16 inches.

**Churchill Lake (including Heron Lake) and tributaries**, upstream to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway blazed line, T9R12 WELS, etc. S-16. Closed to taking whitefish. From August 16 - September 30: tributaries open with a total daily bag limit on trout and togue of 1 fish, S-6. Closed to taking whitefish. Please refer to law regarding fishway dams on page 9.

**Eagle Lake (including Round Pond) and tributaries**, upstream to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway blazed line, T9R13 WELS etc. S-16. Closed to taking whitefish. From August 16 - September 30: tributaries open with a total daily bag limit on trout and togue of 1 fish, S-6. Closed to taking whitefish.

**Little Round Pond and tributaries**, upstream to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway blazed line, T8R13 WELS. S-6, S-16.

- C. The following Allagash Wilderness Waterway waters in Aroostook County are open to open water fishing with the special rule(s) indicated after each - see page 7.

**Allagash River**, from Long Lake Dam downstream to the confluence with the St. John River (including Round Pond, T13R12 WELS) and all tributaries. From August 16 - September 30: S-6. Total daily bag limit on trout and togue: 1 fish.

**Long Lake and outlet to Long Lake Dam (including Harvey Pond) and tributaries**, upstream to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway blazed line, T11&12R13 WELS. S-16. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches. From August 16 - September 30: tributaries open with a total daily bag

limit on trout and togue of 1 fish, S-6. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches.

**Umsaskis Lake (including thoroughfare to Long Lake) and tributaries**, upstream to the Allagash Wilderness Waterway blazed line, T11R13 WELS. S-16. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches. From August 16 - September 30: tributaries open with a total daily bag limit on trout and togue of 1 fish, S-6. Minimum length on whitefish: 16 inches.

AWW Watercraft Restrictions (Summary):

- A. From the south end of Telos Lake to the north end of Chamberlain Lake, the use of all models of personal watercraft (PWC), hovercraft, airboats, racing boats, and pontoon boats is prohibited.
- B. From Lock Dam Stream, where it enters Eagle Lake north to twin Brook Rapids, only canoes without motors or motors not exceeding 10 hp, may be used on the watercourse.
- C. On Allagash Lake and Allagash Stream to the red markers at the entrance of Chamberlain Lake, all watercraft are prohibited except canoes without motors.
- D. Except on Telos and Chamberlain Lakes, the use of inflatable watercraft is prohibited.
- E. Water skiing or other activities in which individuals are towed behind watercraft are prohibited.
