

SAGADAHOC COUNTY

See general law fishing provisions on page 5, and special rules for Maine's southern and eastern counties on page 16. Some waters may have special rules that differ from general law.

If the Sagadahoc County water you wish to fish IS listed below, the letter code will direct you to the rule(s) which are in effect that differ from general law or the special provisions for Maine's southern and eastern counties. The meanings of the letter codes are as follows:

- B:** Closed to ice fishing until January 1, then open to ice fishing and open water fishing from January 1 - March 31.
- S:** Special rule(s) in effect - Special Rules (S-codes) are listed on page 7.
(Note: Special rules may restrict the general law fishing provisions.)

Unless indicated otherwise below, on lakes and ponds in Sagadahoc County the daily bag limit on brook trout is 2 fish.

Androscoggin River. (See Androscoggin County)

Center Pond, Phippsburg. B.

Nequasset Lake, Woolwich. B. No vehicles on ice (ATVs and snowmobiles exempted). Motorboats with more than 10 horsepower prohibited.

Pleasant (Mud) Pond, Richmond. (See Kennebec County)

Sewall Pond, Arrowsic. Motorboats with internal combustion engines prohibited.

Silver Lake, Phippsburg. B.

Wildlife Management Area, Richmond. S-9.

Winnegance Pond, West Bath. Minimum length limit on pickerel: 12 inches.
