The project will include a removal of existing cribbing, construction of new timber cribbing, installation of new wood guardrail, paved ADA access path, and associated site work and landscaping.

Submit proposals made upon blank forms provided, which must be accompanied by certified or cashier's check for 5% of the proposal, or a satisfactory bid bond in a similar amount. Such check or bid bond will be returned to the bidder unless forfeited under the conditions stipulated in the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to waive all formalities, and reject any and all bids, or to accept any bid.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a 100% Contract Performance Bond and 100% Contract Payment Bond to cover the execution of the work for the full amount of the contract price and any subsequent additions or deductions. This project is subject to minimum labor wage rates per Wage Rates Determinations # HB-006-2012 and # HI-006-2012.
