

## **NOTICE TO GENERAL CONTRACTORS REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS**

In conformance with Title 5 M.R.S.A., Section 1747, the State of Maine Bureau of General Services and Department of Transportation will qualify General Contractors to bid on the new RSU #64 Elementary School Project located in Corinth, ME.

Interested General Contractors are required to complete a Pre-Bid Qualification Application in order to receive the construction documents and participate in the bidding process. General Contractors that are currently pre-qualified by BGS/DOT specifically for "Buildings" are not required to submit a new application. Contractors currently prequalified for buildings are required to send Notice of Intent to Bid by e-mail to [peter.glasow@maine.gov](mailto:peter.glasow@maine.gov) by the deadline noted below. A confirmation receipt will be sent. Any General Contractors not currently pre-qualified by BGS/DOT are directed to complete the State of Maine Prequalification Application for this specific project.

The application must be completed and returned electronically to Sonya Everett, at [contractor.prequal@maine.gov](mailto:contractor.prequal@maine.gov), on or before Friday August 1, 2014 at 2 p.m. A confirmation of receipt will be sent. Applications received after this deadline will not be accepted. This deadline supersedes all other published instructions for application acceptance including Section 2.2.2 of the application and the notice on the DOT Contractor Prequalification web page.

The project consists of construction of a new elementary school at 118 Main Street (Route 15), Corinth, Maine. Estimated construction cost is \$21,000,000. The scope of work includes approximately 97,000 of new construction including multi-story steel frame building with masonry veneer, which will contain classrooms, library, cafeteria, kitchen, gymnasium and offices, associated mechanical, electrical, plumbing, sprinkler, and site work, including utilities, drives, parking lots, and playfield.

Bidding documents prepared by Harriman Architects & Engineers will be available to prequalified General Contractor bidders no earlier than September 11, 2014, with Notice to Proceed anticipated in late October 2014 and Substantial Completion by August 1, 2016. Bid document information will be provided in advertisements to follow.
