**ARCHITECTS/ENGINEERS**  
**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS**

Northern Maine Community College wishes to procure architectural and engineering services for the construction of a new maintenance building. The project includes, but is not limited to the design, renovation, and construction of a new maintenance building with a connection to an existing maintenance garage. The new maintenance building will include office, shop, and storage spaces.

The scope of services will include, but not be limited to, field verification and documentation of existing conditions, design development, contract documents, bidding, and construction administration. The firm may be required to coordinate this work and/or additional work with other consultants contracted by Northern Maine Community College.

Interested firms should submit 4 copies of a letter of interest, each with a "Statement of Qualifications." This "Statement of Qualifications" should include: 1) the firm's qualifications to undertake this project; 2) the firm's experience with budget and cost control including the results of the firm's activities; 3) a listing of projects that demonstrate the firm's capabilities; 4) a listing of recently completed work on similar type and size projects including contact information of the client or project contact for each project; 5) profiles of key personnel who will be involved in the design work; 6) a statement of current workload; 7) a listing of business references other than those listed above, including contact information; and 8) additional information that you believe would be useful in evaluating the firm's qualifications. If a firm intends to undertake the project jointly with another firm or by the use of consultants, please include information on the other known firms to be used. Letters of interest with attached qualifications statements should be sent to the following address must be received no later than 1:00 p.m. on March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

Responding firms will be screened and interviewed on the basis of the qualifications only. Specific design concepts or solutions for this project **will not** be discussed at the interview.

# Evaluation Criteria

The evaluation criteria will be used and considered in the evaluation of written submissions and interviews. The scoring weight is listed for each criterion. Additional information required for proper assessment of submissions may be requested from the A&E firms at the discretion of NMCC.

Evaluation will be made per the following criteria:

1. Completeness

Each response will be reviewed prior to the selection process for completeness and adherence to format. A response will be considered complete if all requested sections are included in the proper order and the proposal is complete with all requested information.

2. Evaluation of Responses

A. Evaluation Process

NMCC will appoint a selection committee to formally evaluate each response. The evaluation process will be used to grade the responses as described herein. The evaluation process may include verification of references, confirmation of financial information and may include other information as directed by NMCC.

B. Grading Format

Each section or subsection of the response will be considered a separate selection criterion and will be graded individually. All scores will be summed to give the grand total score. The maximum possible total score for the response is 100 points. Scoring will be summarized on the Formal Evaluation Form.

C. Point Values for items to be graded

D. Percentage Grades

Grade	Description
0%	Criterion was not addressed or the material presented was totally without merit.
20%	Criterion was addressed minimally, indicated little capability, experience, or understanding of topic.
40%	Criterion was addressed minimally, but shows some capability, experience, or understanding of topic.
60%	Criterion was addressed adequately. Overall, a basic capability, experience, or understanding of topic.
80%	Criterion was addressed well. Indicates some superior features.
100%	Criterion was addressed in superior fashion, indicating excellent or outstanding capability.

E. Example

A typical criterion has a point value of 10 points. If a response addresses the topic well (the definition of the 80% grade) the 10-point value for the criterion would be multiplied by 80%, resulting in a score of 8.0.
