As I begin recruitment efforts for the Maine Academy of Natural Sciences (MeANS) 2015-2016 school year, it appears we will have 52 available slots to reach 110 students. We would like to enroll 30 freshmen, 16 sophomores, six juniors and no seniors. We presently have 28 juniors who will be seniors next year.

We believe that by setting the above caps the purpose of our standards-based high school will be enhanced, resulting in increased positive outcomes. In addition, the opportunity to build a positive school culture is strengthened with students entering the school at a younger age and with same age peers.
