



Guest Speaker Troy Frost

Troy was born and raised on a farm in Pittsfield, Maine. He attended local schools through high school, graduating from, Maine Central Institute. He went on to attend the University of Maine at Orono and graduated in 1986 with a Bachelor's Degree in psychology. Shortly after graduation, he began his career as a family teacher at Good Will-Hinckley. He later became a teacher and athletic director, associate principal and eventually Principal of

Averill/Alford School, a position he held until the school's closing in 2009. During this time he also earned his Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from the University of Maine.

Troy received the following awards during his time at Averill/Alford School: Teacher of the Year, the Glenn Stratton Memorial Award and the Good Will-Hinckley Administrative Leadership Award.

Troy went on to serve as Co-Director and eventually Principal of the Maine Academy of Natural Sciences from 2011, when it was established, until August, 2015. In 2013, he received the Commissioner's Award for his work with youth in education. In 2015, he was recognized by the Maine Principals Association as a nominee for Principal of The Year.

He currently resides in Waterville with his wife, Stephanie, and daughter, Sadie. Troy is an avid sports fan who enjoys jogging, golfing, collecting sports cards and spending time with his family.

Honorary Graduate Bill Lord

Bill Lord – Born 1949 in Norway, Maine, grew up in North Lovell Me (Oxford County), Graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1967, he was captain of the wrestling team. Served our country in the United States Air Force from 1968 to 1972 as an Aircraft mechanic – served one year in Vietnam as a Crew Chief on a C-123 Assault and Transport in Special Operations. From 1972 to 1974 he lived off the land with his soon to be wife and new baby, who were married in 1973. From 1974 to 1977 he worked as an auto and truck mechanic. 1977-1981 he attended University of South Carolina and the Medical University of South Carolina – graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy. 1981 to 1986 worked at Maine General in Waterville as a Respiratory Therapist. 1986-1988 took care of WW II Vets at home with Respiratory needs. Became a business owner in 1988 – a business called Tech Medical – he provided home oxygen and medical equipment to home care patients in the central Maine area, he sold the business in 1995. He was also the President of the Maine Society for Respiratory Care and also a delegate to the American Association of Respiratory care in Denver and Dallas. He went back to school and received his Masters in Social Work from University of Maine at Orono in 1998. 1996 he was a Social Worker Intern at GWH and was hired as an LCSW at GWH from 1998 to 2009. From 2004-2012 he had a private practice as an LCSW. He is married to his wife Kathleen and with two sons Zachary (who is 40) and Tyson (who is 34).

He is currently working with our Maine Academy of Natural Sciences students and College Step up Students as a trusted Counselor and Friend.
