Clarifying Question RFP 2015:

Or would it be better to simply get the Board in place first and then start the process of making a very strong and well thought out application with everyone's input and buy in from the beginning?

Answer:

All public charter school applications have to be complete and submitted by August 25, 2014, to be considered in this round of applications. The complete application cannot be considered an 'initial' proposal that could be subject to modification based on what the applicant might hear from the Commission during the process.
