**PUBLIC NOTICE**

In accordance with 5 M.R.S.A Section 6200 et seq., the Land for Maine's Future Board announces that it will be voting on a proposal to allocate funds to support the Maine Department of Marine Resources' acquisition of a Working Waterfront covenant on 1.1± acres of land located in South Bristol, Lincoln County, State of Maine. The property is located at 35 Thompson Inn Road, South Bristol, ME and is identified on South Bristol tax Map 17 as Lot 51. The Maine Department of Marine Resources anticipates that the property will continue to be used for commercial fisheries purposes.
