Although similar to procedures followed by LURC for all rezoning and permit reviews, this information is intended for reviewers of the Maine Mountain Power Redington Wind Farm proposal, and should only be used for that project. - 4. <u>Request for public hearing</u>: March 13, 2006 Commission meeting to be held in Augusta. For a Planned Development Subdistrict, a public hearing is required. The request for the hearing must be taken by staff to the Commission with 45 days of accepting the petition as complete for processing. The public hearing date will be discussed at this meeting, and may or may not be set at that time. Interested parties will be notified of the public hearing date when it is set, LURC will issue a press release, and the date will be posted on LURC's website.
