NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

LURC ZONING PETITION ZP 707

PROPOSED CONCEPT PLAN FOR PLUM CREEK'S LANDS IN THE MOOSEHEAD LAKE REGION PISCATAQUIS AND SOMERSET COUNTIES, MAINE

On October 1, 2008, the Land Use Regulation Commission (“Commission”) approved a set of amendments to Zoning Petition ZP 707, Plum Creek’s Concept Plan proposal the Moosehead Lake region, and directed its staff to develop specific language to implement those amendments (“draft implementing language”). The Commission now seeks public comment on this draft implementing language.

PUBLIC COMMENT DEADLINE
