Guided nature programs, free with park admission. Starting at 2:00 PM at the circle of benches by the second parking lot unless otherwise noted, weather permitting.

These one hour programs may include walks, talks, and activities in a beautiful natural setting. Starred (*) programs are wheelchair accessible; some programs meet at the shore across from Googins Island (S). You may stop by these programs any time between 2:00 and 3:00 PM. No reservations needed except for group programs.

Park admission is \$1.00 for ages 5-11, \$3.00 for Maine residents ages 12-64, \$4.50 for nonresidents ages 12-64, \$1.50 for nonresidents 65 and older; persons under 5 and Maine residents 65 and older are free.
