DEST Trail Guide

Overview, highlights, and three section maps.

Washington Junction to Ayers Junction = 85 miles

85 miles and growing, the Down East Sunrise Trail (DEST) is a year-round multi-use rail trail, and the longest off-road section of the East Coast Greenway.

This Guide provides a trail overview, highlights and near-trail amenities, and three section maps:

- 1. Washington Junction to Cherryfield (28 miles)
- 2. Cherryfield to Machias (29 miles)
- 3. Machias to Ayers Junction (28 miles)

Trail Surface is an old rail bed packed with gravel. Bridge surfaces include wood planking.

Use Types:

Junctions

- 1. Non-motorized use includes but is not limited to bicycling (mountain bikes recommended), hiking, horseback riding, snowshoeing, dog sledding, and skiing.
- 2. All motorized vehicles must be legally registered as either an ATV and/or snowmobile.

Seasonal trail uses and closures are based on trail condition and are posted on trail. Please note:

1. Trail closures may occur during mud season (typically in April/May), for trail repairs, and for snow-dependent seasonal uses.

2. During mud season only human foot traffic is allowed: walking and jogging.

3. Trail Alerts and closures are posted on the Sunrise Trail Coalition website www.sunrisetrail.org.

Mileage is listed on trail by mile post markers. Mile posts are denoted in this guide by "MP=."

= ATV and snowmobile trails that cross the DEST.
