RE: Milestone® FIFRA Section 24(c)Special Local Need Label for Control of Herbaceous Broadleaf Weeds and Woody Plants in Conifer Forest Site Preparation Sites

Corteva Agriscience would like to request an extension to the Milestone[®] FIFRA Section 24(c) Special Local Need Label referenced above which currently expires on 31-Dec-2022.

The active ingredient contained within Milestone[®], Aminopyralid, has been undergoing registration review at US EPA, therefore Corteva has not proceeded with adding this use to the Section 3 label. Once US EPA completes approval of the revised labels that were submitted because of registration review, Corteva will proceed with the appropriate regulatory action to add this use to the Milestone[®] Section 3 label.

Milestone® continues to fill an unmet need in the use for control of herbaceous broadleaf weeds and woody plants in conifer forest site preparation sites. A letter of support has also been submitted by Ronald C. Lemin, Jr of Nutrien Solutions, dated October 24, 2022 to further validate this unmet need, and the benefit that the Milestone® product provides. Corteva hopes that the state of Maine will continue to support Milestone® for this use by extending the current Section 24 Special Local Need.
