ADDITIONAL NOTES FROM MAINE IT SECURITY SME:

Positive notes(PN):

- According to Appendix Q Section L-8 (PII Processing and Transparency) "We do not store of process PII within the spirits business". (re-affirmed with agency (Tracy Willett))
- 2. Vendor utilizes NIST CSF Crosswalk for tracking control changes
- 3. 3rd party vendors routinely audited & tested
 - a. Including supply-chain risk management

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4. Re-evaluates scope and compliance of PII Processing and Transparency yearly (*Appendix Q - Section L-8 (PII Processing and Transparency)*).

Exceptions(E):

- 1. Appendix Q Section L-PL4 (Rules of Behavior)
 - a. Vendor plan of action is acceptable
- 2. Appendix Q Section L-PL7 (Concept of Operations)
 - a. Vendor plan of action is acceptable

Notes of concern(NC):

- 1. Compliance of security controls is noted (through the RFP CSF-NIST crosswalk) but not defined (i.e. 'how' for example "physical environment is monitored for potential threats" but how is this accomplished?). I don't feel this should impede the RFP process or negatively impact the bidder, however it is worth noting that if the bidder were selected, we would want to see this level of detail. That is often accomplished through 3rd party audits of the vendors environment (such as a SOC2 Type II which the vendor notes they conduct (see Appendix Q Section L:Conclusion) and Section N covers the requirement for that report).
- 2. System/communications protections noted in Appendix Q Section L-14. Data at rest / in transit is protected this is an area that would be important to know the 'how' (see NC-1 from this notes section). Though from a risk standpoint this becomes less critical based on the agency defined low-sensitivity of data. The bidder goes on to further support this in 14:SC-12/SC-13 (Cryptographic protection(s)) and appears to establish a low sensitivity "We believe this falls beyond the scope of the impact level of the data as determined by the agency"
- 3. As a managed service solution, details on **Appendix Q Section L-14:CSF PR.AC-5** (**Network Segmentation**) would be good to have but not critical given the low datasensitivity. By policy, sensitive data should not be stored in a way that another client's data is accessible to SOM data (*client in the case meaning for instance, another client provided services by the vendor*).
- 4. For PN-4 (above), as data-owners, I would recommend the agency be involved in this review.
