


Here's how to get your flu shot covered at 100%

- ✔ Schedule an appointment with your physician
- ✔ Go to an in-network flu vaccine provider (listed on the next page)
- ✔ Go to an out-of-network flu vaccine provider (If you choose this option, you may have to pay up front and submit a claim for reimbursement.)

If you received a separate flu card in the past, you'll no longer need it. We have now contracted with flu vaccine providers that will bill us directly, so all you need is your member ID card.
