Findings of Fact and Order
Air Emission License
Transfer

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, M.R.S.A., Section 590 and Chapter 2 of the Department Regulations, the Department finds the following facts:

I. Registration

Sargent Materials, Inc. (Sargent) has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-294-71-K-R/A from Vaughn Thibodeau & Sons, Inc. to Sargent Materials, Inc. through a transfer application to the Bureau of Air Quality dated July 6, 2010. The air license transfer is for the operation of emission sources associated with the concrete batch plant equipment.

Concrete Batch Plant

Equipment	Process Rate	Manufacturer	Control Device
Batch Plant	80 cubic yards/hour	Erie	baghouse
Portable Batch Plant	50 cubic yards/hour	Erie	baghouse

The portable rock crushers and diesel generators on the air license are not part of this air license transfer.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, Sargent submitted copies of property deeds transferring ownership of the facility. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Financial Capacity and Intent

Sargent states that they possess the financial capacity to operate the facility in compliance with its air emission license.

C. Technical Capacity and Intent

Sargent's acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees that currently operate the equipment, facilities, and conduct other activities. The facility's regulatory history with the MEDEP demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that Sargent has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

E. Certification

Sargent certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.

Based on the above, the Department concludes that the applicant for the air emission license transfer has the capacity to satisfy all applicable statutory criteria and hereby APPROVES the transfer of Air Emission License A-294-71-K-R/A, from Vaughn Thibodeau & Sons, Inc. to Sargent Materials Inc., subject to all conditions attached to them.
