Findings of Fact and Order
Air Emission License
Amendment #1**

After review of the air emissions license amendment application, staff investigation reports and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 M.R.S.A., §344 and §590, the Department finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

A. Introduction

1. Oak Grove Crematory (Oak Grove) was issued Air Emission License A-1022-71-A-N on October 5, 2009, permitting the operation of emission sources associated with their human crematory facility.
2. Oak Grove has requested a minor revision to their license in order to extend the period to commence construction by a period of 18 months.

B. Application Classification

This amendment will not increase emissions of any pollutant. Therefore, this modification is determined to be a minor revision and has been processed as such.

II. BEST PRACTICAL TREATMENT (BPT)

A. Introduction

In order to receive a license the applicant must control emissions from each unit to a level considered by the Department to represent Best Practical Treatment (BPT), as defined in *Definitions Regulation*, 06-096 CMR 100 (as amended). Separate control requirement categories exist for new and existing equipment as well as for those sources located in designated non-attainment areas.

There have been no changes that will affect the BACT analysis submitted with the application for Oak Grove's air emission license.

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ORDER

Based on the above findings and subject to the conditions listed below, the Department concludes the emissions from this source:

- will receive Best Practical Treatment,
- will not violate applicable emission standards,
- will not violate applicable ambient air quality standards in conjunction with emissions from other sources.

The Department here by grants Air Emission License A-1022-71-B-M, subject to the following conditions:

The following Specific Condition Number (17) shall be added to Air Emission License A-1022-71-A-N:

The Period for commencement of construction as set out in Standard Condition (3) shall be extended by a period of 18 months, until October 5, 2012.
