Findings of Fact and Order
Air Emission License
Transfer**

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, M.R.S.A., Section 590 and Chapter 2 of the Department Regulations, the Department finds the following facts:

I. Registration

Huhtamaki, Inc. has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-416-70-A-I from Huhtamaki Foodservice, Inc. to Huhtamaki, Inc. through a letter to the Bureau of Air Quality dated March 25, 2010. On January 1, 2010, Huhtamaki Foodservice, Inc. merged with Huhtamaki Packaging, Inc. who subsequently changed its name to Huhtamaki, Inc.. Air Emission License A-416-70-A-I was issued to Huhtamaki Foodservice, Inc. on January 14, 2002. The facility, located at 242 College Avenue in Waterville, Maine, is a manufacturing facility that uses recycled food board, newspaper, milk carton stock and other similar paper materials to produce pulp products. Cellulose fibers are mechanically cleaned and vacuum-drawn from a liquid slurry onto pre-shaped wire dies, where they are formed, compressed and dried into finished products. Finished products include paper plates, pizza trays, food trays, and other similar laminated products.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Financial Capacity and Intent

Huhtamaki, Inc. states that they possess the financial capacity to operate the facility in compliance with its air emission license.

C. Technical Capacity and Intent

Huhtamaki, Inc.'s acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees that currently operate the equipment, facilities, and conduct other activities. The facility's regulatory history with the Department of Environmental Protection demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that Huhtamaki, Inc. has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

Huhtamaki, Inc. certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.


ORDER
