After review of the Part 70 License Administrative Revision application, staff investigation reports and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 M.R.S.A, Section 344 and Section 590, the Department finds the following facts:

### **B. Description of Revision**

Domtar is currently following the opacity standard option of MEDEP Chapter 101, section 2(B)(2)(a)(ii) for #3 Recovery Boiler. During an inspection by a technical consultant in June 2006, significant damage to the ESP collection plates was discovered. Until the #3 Recovery Boiler ESP is repaired, Domtar requests that they follow the opacity standard option of Chapter 101, section 2(B)(2)(a)(i). While Domtar is subject to this opacity standard option, #3 Recovery Boiler is required to operate with both ESP chambers in operation except for periods of startup, shutdown, and malfunction. This opacity standard option shall be in effect until Sept 30th, 2007, at which time the opacity standard option shall revert back to Chapter 101, section 2(B)(2)(a)(ii). Single chamber ESP operation may then resume pending successful single ESP chamber stack tests.

C. Application Classification

The Department hereby grants Part 70 Administrative Revision A-215-70-G-A, subject to the conditions found in Part 70 License A-215-70-A-I, and in the following conditions:

This License shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
