Findings of Fact and Order
Part 70 Air Emission License
Amendment #1**

After review of the air emission license amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 M.R.S.A, Section 344 and Section 590, the Department finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

This administrative amendment includes the following date changes to the Part 70 license:

- * Semiannual Report due date revised from July 30, 2005 to July 30, 2006,
- * Annual Compliance Certification due date revised from January 30, 2006 to January 30, 2007, and
- * Stack Test date revised for As, Ni, Cr, and Be from July 30, 2006 to October 30, 2006.

B. Application Classification

This amendment is classified as a Part 70 Administrative Revision to correct typographical errors. The dates in the last draft of the license were not updated prior to the issuance of the Part 70 license. These date corrections do not affect emissions or equipment at the facility.

II. PART 70 ADMINISTRATIVE REVISION DESCRIPTIONS

The Part 70 Air Emission License A-283-70-A-I was issued on December 14, 2005 with three due dates listed in error.

Condition (21) of license A-283-70-A-I, requires “The semiannual reports are due with every other quarterly report, and the initial semiannual report is due July 30, 2005.” With this administrative revision, the initial semiannual report shall be due July 30, 2006.

Condition (22) of license A-283-70-A-I, requires “The initial annual compliance certification is due January 30, 2006.” With this administrative revision, the initial annual compliance certification shall be due January 30, 2007.

Condition (14)(G)(1)(b)(iv) of license A-283-70-A-I states, in part: “RWS shall stack test for As, Ni, Cr, and Be by June 30, 2006.” During the final review process of the draft license, it was agreed upon that the date for the stack testing would be in the fall to be consistent with the facility’s annual compliance testing schedule. The date was not corrected prior to the draft issuance. With this administrative revision, the stack testing for As, Ni, Cr, and Be shall be performed by October 30, 2006.

ORDER

Based on the above Findings and subject to conditions listed below the Department concludes that the emissions from this source:

- will receive Best Practical Treatment,
- will not violate applicable emission standards, and
- will not violate applicable ambient air quality standards, or increment standards either alone or in conjunction with emissions from other sources.

Therefore the Department grants this amendment A-283-70-B-A, subject to the conditions found in air emission license A-283-70-A-I, in addition to the following conditions:

The following shall replace condition (14)(G)(1)(b)(iv) in air emission license A-283-70-A-I:

- (14) Municipal Waste Combustors A and B
(G)(1)(b)(iv) RWS shall stack test for As, Ni, Cr, and Be by October 30, 2006. Within 60 days following the stack test, RWS shall submit proposed emission limits for As, Ni, Cr, and Be. Stack testing for As, Ni, Cr, and Be
