Dear Ms. Howatt:

As you have no doubt heard by now, the Clary Lake Association has finally succeeded in purchasing the Clary Lake dam property from the bankruptcy estate of Paul A. Kelley Jr. The closing took place on on 13 October 2018 after the 14 day automatic stay period of the Bankruptcy Court order approving the sale expired. We are very pleased to submit our application requesting Department approval of the transfer of the Clary Lake Water Level Order #L-22585-36-B-N [WLO] to our organization.

This is the second time we've submitted this license transfer application. The first application, submitted on or about 17 July 2018, was returned to us because we did not get title to the dam in time. In a subsequent followup phone call with you, you said the Department would waive the requirement that we pay the \$158.00 application fee again. This is appreciated!

Also please note: the former owner of the CLD and the current licensee is Pleasant Pond Mill LLC which company is an asset in Mr. Kelley's Bankruptcy Estate. Consequently, Mr. Kelley is not in a position to sign the license transfer application. For this reason we are taking advantage of Chapter 2 of Department Rules Section 21(C)(4) which states:

(4) If the proposed transferee demonstrates that the original licensee no longer has sufficient title, right or interest in the property subject to the license, the Department may allow the transfer application to be processed without the signature of the original licensee.

In our first application we included a breakdown of costs to repair the dam and bring the property into compliance with the Water Level Order. Unfortunately, we have had to revise our dam repair plan and do not have updated costs associated with dam repairs at this time.



Beginning at a point on the assumed right of way of said Route 218 at land of AquaFortis Associates LLC as described in deed dated April 13, 2010 and recorded in Book 4275 Page 85 at the Lincoln County Registry of Deeds, said point being 12 feet, more or less, southerly from the northwesterly corner and 6 feet from the southwesterly side of the Old Mill Building on the herein described premises;

Breakdown of Costs

Dam Purchase:

The dam was purchased from the Bankruptcy Estate of Paul A. Kelley Jr. for \$80,000.

Dam Repairs:

The Clary Lake Association [CLA] has retained the services of Linkel Construction of Topsham Maine to make repairs to the Clary Lake dam sufficient to allow full compliance with the Clary Lake Water Level Order [WLO]. Due to unanticipated but necessary changes in the scope of work to be performed, Linkel Construction's original proposal is no longer valid; they are in the process of preparing a new proposal which was not available at the time of this writing.

WLO Compliance:

1. The CLA is happy with and will be pleased to accept the surveyed NAVD88 elevation of 151.17' of the Normal High Water Line of Clary Lake as established by Pleasant Pond Mill LLC as referenced by the Department's condition letter dated June 7, 2016 (copy attached). The CLA has retained True North Surveying Services of Newcastle Maine to verify the accuracy of the current NAVD88 elevation benchmark at the dam site as well as conduct other non-compliance related surveying activities. The estimated cost of these surveying services is less than \$1000.
2. Special Condition #6 of the WLO requires the installation of a permanently mounted lake level gauge. Forestry Suppliers carries reasonably priced staff gauges in a variety of styles suitable for this purpose. True North Surveying Services will certify to the accurate installation of the staff gauge. We estimate the cost of purchasing and installing this gauge to be \$125.

General Site Work:

The CLA intends to install fencing and signage as appropriate as well as general site work. We anticipate this work and materials to be donated.

The Clary Lake Association (CLA) recently embarked on a successful fundraising campaign, raising almost \$125,000 to purchase and repair the Clary Lake dam. As part of this initial fundraising effort, \$40,000 was pledged by an anonymous donor, \$15,000 of which has been already been given to us. The donor will provide the remaining \$25,000 of matching funds based on our cash management needs. I have personally spoken with the donor and was assured that we have an absolute commitment for the full \$25,000.

Regrettably, the bankruptcy proceedings took longer and cost more money than anticipated. Now that we own the dam, we are in the process of raising an additional \$15,000 towards repairs to the dam. The CLA Board is confident that we will quickly achieve this fundraising goal.

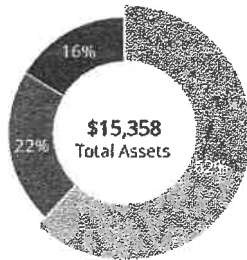

The Technical Ability of the Clary Lake Association as it relates to owning and operating the Clary Lake Dam

For the last 70+ years the Clary Lake dam has been privately owned and operated by individuals without any real demonstrable technical ability for operating a dam other than that which they gained through experience over time. In recent years the dam has been managed primarily but not exclusively to maintain the lake level for the use and enjoyment of the lake shore owners and for the general public for recreational purposes, as a public water supply, and for fire protection. Without an approved water level regime, dam operations have often involved arbitrary decisions regarding what the dam owner felt the lake level ought to be at any given time. As a result, lake levels over the years have fluctuated considerably, impacting public access and damaging the fragile ecology of Clary Lake. All that has changed. There is now a DEP Water Level Order [WLO] on Clary Lake that clearly describes the lake levels and minimum flows to be maintained throughout the year. The Clary Lake Association [CLA] is ready, willing, and able to take on this responsibility.

The CLA is a 501 C(3) organization dedicated to protecting and preserving Clary Lake and is admirably suited for owning and operating the Clary Lake dam [CLD]. The CLA currently has 140 members including 70% of Clary Lake's littoral owners. Our Membership has a vested interest in owning and maintaining the dam and complying with the WLO, and we bring considerable diverse skills and abilities to the task. This is a marked departure from previous dam owners who might have lacked the time, wherewithal, or resources to manage the CLD.

One of the challenges for past dam owners was coming up with the funds for dam operations and repairs. The Clary Lake Association has a proven fundraising track record and we do not anticipate any difficulty in raising the money necessary to maintain and operate the Clary Lake dam. Previous individual dam owners have understandably objected to having to maintain the CLD for the benefit of others, without financial assistance. The CLA on the other hand counts among it's Membership a majority of Clary Lake shore owners who are strongly committed to furthering goals of the CLA and protecting and preserving Clary Lake.

The CLA has retained Linkel Construction of Topsham Maine, a firm experienced in dam construction, repair, and maintenance to help us bring the CLD into operational condition. They will install a weir in the top of the dam with slots on the sides to accommodate stop logs, a solution originally proposed by an engineer with Kleinschmidt Associates back in 1997 but never implemented. This weir will be used to set the lake level at the elevation specified in the WLO. Routine dam operations will involve only adding or removing stop logs from the weir to set the desired lake level. The existing 34" diameter outlet gate will remain functional but will

be kept closed most of the time except when outflows need to be temporarily increased to accommodate increased runoff from significant precipitation events.

The CLA has also retained True North Surveying Services of Newcastle Maine to monument the CLD property corners and set several elevation benchmarks on site which will be used during dam repairs and also for the calibration of a lake level gauge as required by the WLO.

We are confident that we will quickly acquire what we currently may lack in operational experience. The CLD will be in good hands.
