

- C. DEP may offer recommendations to LURC for the issuance, denial or waiver of certification for the proposed activity, including recommendations for specific conditions of approval, based upon DEP's policies and applicable water quality standards and regulations;
  - D. DEP shall provide such additional technical analysis, testimony, and other assistance in water quality certification proceedings as may be requested by LURC; and
  - E. LURC shall make a written statement of its use of DEP's comments and recommendations in reaching its decision.
4. For those activities for which DEP is the certifying agency and which are located in or may affect the resources of the unorganized territories:
- A. DEP shall forward two copies of the project application, along with a request for review comments, to LURC;
  - B. LURC shall comment to DEP in a timely fashion regarding the impacts of the proposed activity on the resources of the unorganized territories and the consistency of the proposed activity with LURC's current Comprehensive Land Use Plan, including all applicable land use standards, goals and policies;
  - C. LURC may offer recommendations to DEP for the issuance, denial or waiver of certification for the proposed activity, including recommendations for specific conditions of approval, based upon LURC's current Comprehensive Land Use Plan, including all applicable land use standards, goals and policies;
  - D. LURC shall provide such additional resource analysis, testimony, and other assistance in water quality certification proceedings as may be requested by DEP; and
  - E. DEP shall make a written statement of its use of LURC's comments and recommendations in reaching its decision.
