I am filing notice of my intent to comply with all requirements of the Maine DEP's General Permit for the Discharge of Graywater or a Mixture of Graywater and Blackwater from a Large Commercial Passenger Vessel to Coastal Water, and associated state rules and statutes. I and my agents, if any, have read and will comply with all such requirements.

I certify that the vessel's graywater and blackwater is permitted and meets the standards specified in Chapter 532(3), "Effluent Standards".

I authorize staff of the Departments of Environmental Protection to access the vessel at reasonable times for the purpose of determining compliance with the General Permit. I also understand that this notification is not valid until approved by the Department or 14 days after receipt of this notification by the Department, whichever is less.

I have attached the following required submittals.

**NOTIFICATION FORMS Will NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE NECESSARY ATTACHMENTS:**

- Attach a check for \$117 (non-refundable) made payable to: "Treasurer, State of Maine".**
- Attach a description of the number, type, and capacity of waste treatment systems that will be used to treat wastewater intended to be authorized for discharge under the general permit.**
- Attach. A description of the maximum anticipated volume of wastewater to be discharged through the Wastewater to be discharged through the wastewater treatment system(s).**
- Attach. A list of anticipated ports of call, as of the time of submitting this form.**

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Keep a copy as a record of notification. Send the form with attachments via certified mail to the Maine Dept. of Environmental Protection, State House Station 17, Augusta, ME 04333-0017. No further authorization by DEP will be issued after receipt of notice. Authorization is valid until the expiration of the general permit, unless revoked by the Department. The DEP will send a copy to the NOI to the anticipated ports of call scheduled as of submission of the NOI, as evidence of the DEP's receipt of notification. No further authorization by DEP will be issued after receipt of notice. Violation of any standard is subject to enforcement action.

**Additional Information and Checklist**

The following submissions are required **each year** a vessel will enter Maine coastal waters.

<b>1. QA/QCP Certification Form.</b> This form is used to certify participation under a Quality Assurance/Quality Control Plan (QA/QCP). The form must be provided <b>not less than 90 days prior to the vessel's initial entry</b> into the coastal waters of Maine. The owner or operator may either certify to participation in a plan approved by the Maine DEP for the current season, or certify to participation in a plan submitted to and approved by the Maine DEP.			
<b>2. QA/QCP Plan.</b> If the owner or operator wishes to certify to a QA/QCP plan submitted to and approved by the Maine DEP, then the plan must be submitted for review <b>at least 150 days prior to the vessel's initial entry</b> into the coastal waters of Maine. The plan is only acceptable if approved by the Department. If not applicable, indicate "NA" at right.			
<b>3. Certification of Conformance with Standards.</b> This is used to certify that the vessel's graywater and mixture of graywater and blackwater is permitted and meets the standards specified in Chapter 532(3), "Effluent Standards". This form must be provided to the Department <b>not less than 30 days nor more than 120 days prior to the vessel's initial entry</b> into the coastal waters of Maine.  Exception: This certification statement is included as part of the Notice of Intent (NOI) form. Therefore the Certification of Conformance with Standards Form does not need to be submitted for the initial season when the NOI is submitted.		<b>X</b>	
<b>4. Vessel Specific Sampling Plan (VSSP).</b> A VSSP must be submitted <b>within 30 days</b> of the vessel's entry into the coastal waters of Maine.
