Transfer**

FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes Annotated (M.R.S.A.), Section 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (CMR) 115 (as amended), the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

I. Registration

Southern Maine Health Care at the Sanford Campus has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-71-71-G-R/M from Henrietta D. Goodall Hospital, Inc. to Southern Maine Health Care through a letter to the Bureau of Air Quality dated October 7, 2014. Air Emission License A-71-71-G-R/M was issued to Henrietta D. Goodall Hospital, Inc. on January 4, 2013. The facility is a healthcare facility.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, Southern Maine Health Care submitted copies of sufficient paperwork displaying the merger of Henrietta D. Goodall Hospital, Inc. into Southern Maine Health Care. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Technical Capacity and Intent

Southern Maine Health Care's acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees that currently operate the equipment, facilities, and conduct other activities. The facility's regulatory history with the Department demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that Southern Maine Health Care has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

D. Certification

Southern Maine Health Care certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.
