FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the air emission license amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 344 and § 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

A. Introduction

Village Green Maine, LLC (Village Green) was issued Air Emission License A-1086-71-A-N on 1/13/2014, for the operation of emission sources associated with their anaerobic digester/energy production facility. The license was subsequently amended on 1/22/2019 (A-1086-71-C-A).

Village Green has requested a minor revision to their license in order to extend the approval to construct the equipment denoted in Air Emission License Amendment A-1086-71-C-A for a further 18 months beyond the July 22, 2020 deadline specified in Standard Condition (3) of Air Emission License A-1086-71-A-N.

The equipment addressed in this license amendment is located at 27 Bioenergy Way, Brunswick Landing of the former Brunswick Naval Air Station in Brunswick, Maine. This address has changed from previous licenses due to the addition of a new named access road to the facility.

B. Application Classification

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the date this license was issued.

This amendment will not increase licensed emissions of any pollutant. Therefore, this amendment is determined to be a minor revision and has been processed as such.

Departmental Findings of Fact and Order Air Emission License Amendment #2

ORDER

Based on the above Findings and subject to conditions listed below, the Department concludes that the emissions from this source:

- will receive Best Practical Treatment,
- will not violate applicable emission standards, and
- will not violate applicable ambient air quality standards in conjunction with emissions from other sources.

The Department hereby grants Air Emission License Amendment A-1086-71-D-M subject to the conditions found in Air Emission License A-1086-71-A-N, and in amendment A-1086-71-C-A.

The approval to construct as authorized in Air Emission License Amendment A-1086-71-C-A (January 22, 2019) is hereby extended for an additional 18 months beyond the original July 22, 2020 authorization, which was specified in accordance with Standard Condition (3) of Air Emission License A-1086-71-A-N (January 13, 2014). Therefore, this approval to construct is valid until January 22, 2022.

<u>Severability</u>. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Amendment or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Amendment shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
