Air Emission License

FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (C.M.R.) ch. 115, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) finds the following facts:

I. Registration

CADC Portland 340, LLC (CADC) has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-1138-71-A-N (issued 11/19/2018) from Sweetwater Partners, LLC to CADC through a letter to the Department dated January 24, 2024. The facility is a data center.

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, CADC submitted copies of property deeds transferring ownership of the facility to CADC. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. <u>Technical Capacity and Intent</u>

In their application, CADC stated they had the technical capacity and intent to comply with all conditions of the air emission license. A commercial property management company, Northland Management Corp, has been retained to oversee the facility. The licensed equipment is comprised of two distillate fuel-fired emergency generators. Compliant operation of such equipment can be reasonably expected of any competent facility maintenance staff. The Department determines there is sufficient evidence that CADC has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

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C. Full Name and Address

D. Certification

CADC certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.

ORDER

Based on the above, the Department concludes that the applicant for the air emission license transfer has the capacity to satisfy all applicable statutory criteria and hereby APPROVES the transfer of Air Emission License A-1138-71-A-N from Sweetwater Partners, LLC to CADC Portland 340, LLC, subject to all conditions attached to it.

<u>Severability</u>. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Transfer or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Transfer shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
