Pursuant to the provision of Title 38 M.R.S.A, Section 483, the Department of Environmental Protection has considered the application of GREAT NORTHERN PAPER COMPANY with its supportive data, staff summary, agency review comments, and other related materials on file and finds the following facts:

1. The applicant received conditional approval from the Department of Environmental Protection by Corrected Order dated 12/20/89 for project #L-16637-20-A-N. The applicant has submitted evidence concerning compliance with Special Condition #2 of this Order.

2. Special Condition #2 reads as follows:

"Prior to construction of the Woodyard Modernization project, the applicant shall submit to the Department for review and receive approval evidence of final commitment of all necessary funds from Great Northern Nekoosa to complete the project."

3. The nature of the evidence submitted is as follows:

A letter to Dean Marriott, Commissioner, Department of Environmental Protection, dated August 30, 1989, from D.C. Wright, Jr., Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, Great Northern Nekoosa Corporation, confirming that the East Millinocket Woodyard Modernization Project was approved by GNN's Board of Directors and that funds totaling \$48,244,000 have been set aside for its implementation.

BASED upon the above Findings of Fact, the Department concludes that Great Northern Paper Company has complied with Special Condition #2 of the Department Order #L-16637-20-A-N, dated 12-20-89.
