Dear Mr. Peterson:

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MEDEP) has determined that the NSGA Corea Operations property located on Route 195 in Corea Village, Gouldsboro is eligible for site assessment activities using the Hancock County Planning Commission's (HCPC's) Brownfield Petroleum Site Assessment funding. Previous investigations at the site indicate that petroleum contamination may be present at the site and distinguishable from hazardous substances.

The current owners of the property and the immediate past owners are not responsible and/or viable. The property is not listed on the MEDEP's petroleum priority list and is not subject to any enforcement actions under RCRA.
