All:

This communication is to acknowledge that Jeffrey Mabee and Judith Grace consent to the site walk by the new board members and BEP-DEP-AG staff on their intertidal land and request that the new members be properly briefed — with relevant materials — prior to the site visit on the TRI issues in the intertidal area. In addition, as counsel for the Holder of the recorded Conservation Easement on the intertidal land that the new Board members will be touring, the Friends of the Harriet L. Hartley Conservation Area, I also extend the Holder's consent at this time for the site visit on this land.

Ms. Bensinger and Bertocci, can you clarify if — prior to that site visit — these new members will be provided the prior-filed objections and responses relating to TRI, so that these new members understand that Intervenors Mabee and Grace have objected to the BEP exercising jurisdiction and proceeding with the permitting process in the absence of NAF having administrative standing to seek permits for this land and the Board lacking jurisdiction to grant any permits to use this land since the applicant lacks a cognizable expectation to use the land in the manner proposed.

Specifically, please advise if the new members have received:

- 1. The prior objections and response including exhibits;
- 2. The Ferris v. Hargrave judgment;
- 3. The renewed objection relating to the 12-24-2019 Amendment of the NAF-Eckrote Easement (option);
- 4. The August 31, 2012 Good Deeds survey showing the waterside boundary ending "along high water";
- 5. The April 2, 2018 Good Deeds survey warning NAF that the Eckrotes lacked the ability to grant an easement below their high water mark;
- The April 29, 2019 Conservation Easement to preserve this intertidal land in its natural condition;
- 7. The November 5, 2019 Assignment of the Conservation Easement from Upstream Watch to Friends of the Harriet L. Hartley Conservation Area;
- 8. The November 2019 survey and related report by Donald R. Richards; and

9. The 12-20-2019 and 1-24-2020 Superior Court Orders denying NAF's special motions to dismiss on all grounds except striking the injunctive claim seeking to stop NAF from making false claims of sufficient TRI to permitting agencies.

Since TRI will be an issue these members must decide, even though we have been denied the due process hearing to raise these issues directly with them with appropriate witnesses, we request if they have not received this information that they be provided it to read for themselves prior to the site visit.

If you do not have copies of any of the documents above, please advise me and I will forward them to you.

I am attaching the sketches from Donald Richards for the new members' use so that they can orient themselves to the evolution of the deeds and the nature of these claims. We request that they be provided these sketches prior to the site visit since Intervenors Mabee and Grace, the Lobstering Representatives, and the Holder of the conservation Easement are waiving our right to be present for this site visit and granting permission to tour this property. This opportunity for the new members to see this area in person is important, but will be an opportunity squandered if they do not understand the ownership and jurisdictional issues related to this area while they are there on the ground.

We also ask that they be provided with a copy of the Phase II Mallinckrodt chart showing where the mercury is known to be present and the levels of buried mercury in the sediment found by the Court's experts in this area (attached below). Exiting Board members have seen this chart before and i is imperative that the new members have the same level of information for next week's hearing.

Thank you for your consideration and attention to these requests for clarification of the level of information the new members have received prior to the site visit, and your assistance in disseminating the important information listed above prior to that site visit.

Chronology of Lot Development At Little River, Belfast, Maine 1934 - 1991

This set of sketches depicts the development of certain lots at the Little River area of Belfast. The purpose is to show how the lots were created and what was included in the lots with explanatory notes.

Sketch One shows the current Belfast tax map configuration with lots annotated to show the names of current owners.

Sketch Two shows the extent of the Harriet Hartley property situated easterly of Northport Avenue (U. S. Route 1) in 1946 and the first parcel she created in 1946 and sold off to Fred R. Poor.

Sketch Three shows the second parcel Harriet Hartley created in 1946 and sold to Sam M. Cassida

Sketch Four shows the remaining land of Harriet Hartley which she sold to William P. & Pauline H. Butler in 1950.

Sketch Five shows the location of the last lot created by then owner Ernest J. and Marjorie N. Bell which was conveyed to John Joseph & Catherine Grady. That lot was later conveyed to Larry D. Theye and Betty Becker Theye in 1992.

Sketch six shows the location of the Winston C. Ferris parcel which was subsequently conveyed to Jeffrey R. Mabee and Judith B. Grace. The subsequent development of the Ekrote, Morgan and Helmers lots and other lots to the north were created over a series of conveyances from Fred R. Poor and successors in interest to Sam M. Cassida. The development and reconfiguration of those parcels did not affect the ownership, boundaries, title or rights of the Mabee - Grace property.

Additional notes and annotations are provided on the various pages.

Any land owned by Harriet L. Hartley west of Northport Avenue or U. S. Route 1 was not considered for this study.

This illustrated compilation of sketches is based in part on government documents including tax maps, Maine GIS photos, contours and parcel configurations and deeds and plans of record but does not constitute a boundary survey. The North Arrow shown on the sketches as taken from the tax map is True North.
