Please accept these as my comments on the petition of DEP to withdraw certain areas of Maine from the Ozone Transport Region pursuant to the Clean Air Act.

I am strongly opposed to such an action. Being part of the Ozone Transport Region has served Maine well, and should not be changed. There have been a number of times this summer alone when unhealthy levels of ozone have occurred in Maine.
