Dear Erle:

In response to your request for additional information attached is a detail of the area of wetland clearing. The total length of the transmission line is 4,300 linear feet; 2,520 feet are immediately adjacent to the CMP corridor, and 1,780 feet depart from the CMP corridor in order to avoid Lot 40-1. Note that the transmission line is adjacent to the CMP corridor as it heads down the mountain until just before it reaches Lot 40-1, and then rejoins the CMP corridor after Lot 40-1 as the line approaches Route 120. Additionally, the Applicant has confirmed that guy wires will be confined to the proposed right-of-way corridor, including in the area where the line departs from the CMP corridor in order to avoid Lot 40-1.
