- b) facility boundaries;
- c) location of the AWSF within the facility;
- d) site security system;
- e) fences and gates;
- f) existing structures within 500 feet of the AWSF boundary lines with the owner(s) name(s) and address(es); and
- g) most recent full sized (7 1/2 minute if available) US Geological Survey topographic map

Note: An AWSF must not be located within 500 feet of any public or private school, day care or pre-school or any other such building utilized for the education of students in grades K-12. A waiver may be granted by the Department under extenuating circumstances where pre-existing storage facilities are currently located within 500 feet of educational facilities described above and no other feasible storage alternative exists.

3. AWSF OPERATIONS MANUAL:

Please provide an AWSF Manual that, as a minimum, addresses the following points:

- a) the AWSF will be locked and impact resistant;
 - b) the asbestos waste will be packaged in two layers of 6-mil fiber-tight polyethylene sheeting or bags;
 - c) the asbestos waste will be kept adequately wet during storage;
 - d) the labeling system for asbestos waste will conform with the OSHA Asbestos Standard, 29 CFR 1926.58 (effective July 20, 1986) and General Industry, 29 CFR 1910.1001 (effective October 14, 1988);
 - e) method(s) for handling containerized waste;
- Note:** Containerized asbestos waste must not be dropped or thrown further than three feet.
- f) methods for handling improperly packaged asbestos waste including, but not limited to, leaking bags or dry asbestos waste; and
 - g) that site security procedures will prevent unauthorized entry to the AWSF site.

By signing this application, the applicant and the person preparing the application certify that the information constituting this notification for permit by rule is complete and accurate to the best of their knowledge. All applicable requirements of Chapter 425, Section 9 will be met in the siting and operations of this Asbestos Waste Storage Facility.
