

Notice of Agency Rule-making Adoption

CHAPTER NUMBER AND TITLE: 882, Designation of Bisphenol A as a Priority Chemical and Regulation of Bisphenol A in Consumer Products (Sections 1-4 and 6)

ADOPTED RULE NUMBER: 2011.3

CONCISE SUMMARY

The finally adopted portion of Chapter 882 (Sections 1-4 and 6): a) designates bisphenol A as a priority chemical, b) requires manufacturers of toys, tableware and infant formula and baby food sold in containers that contain intentionally-added bisphenol A to report information on the use and likelihood of exposure to children of bisphenol A from use of those products, and c) requires manufacturers of infant formula and baby food sold in containers that contain intentionally-added bisphenol A to submit an alternatives assessment to the department.
