



# A-04-5 Prescott Park to Pierces Island to Goat Island

## Strategy Implementation

This is a 2 part exclusionary strategy.

1. Establish communications with Command Center.
2. Use current to assist deployment.
3. Deploy Resources:
 

**PART 1** Between Goat and Pierces Islands in front of Shapleigh Island bridge  
 1,250 feet of boom between permanent anchor pins on each Island.  
 Goat Island pin is just after the bridge coming from Portsmouth near the high tide line.  
 Pierces Island pin is located on a large ledge below a utility pole, just below the high tide line.  
 This is on the shore of the waste treatment plant.

**PART 2** Pierces Island to Prescott Park  
 750 feet from east side of pier near boom storage shed location at the Coop Fish Pier to the gravel boat ramp near the Prescott Park pier boat ramp.
4. Observe deployment for stability and adjust as necessary.
5. Prepare to recover oil?
