



B-42-1 Lower Damariscotta River - Little River

<i>Site Access</i>	East Boothbay Harbor boat ramp. By land: From Route 1, take Rte. 27 south to Boothbay Harbor, and Rte. 96 east to Linekin. Road immediately adjacent to cove.
