




# C-50-2 Bartlett Narrows: Pretty Marsh Harbor / Birch Cove

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# Bartlett Narrows: Pretty Marsh Harbor / Birch Cove

*Port Region* Penobscot Bay

*Latitude Longitude* 44° 20.346' N 68° 25.452' W

*Water Depth Range* 30 feet

*Max Current (knots)* *Flood*  *Ebb*  *Source*

*Nearest Boat Ramp* Bartlett Island Landing 1 NM. Bartlett Island ferry / barge: private barge maintained by Rockefeller Estates on Bartlett Island.

*Response Strategy Type* Exclusion

*Type of Boom* Harbor

*Total Length of Boom* 2500 feet Unless otherwise indicated, the boom length given is straight line distance as measured on the map. Actual length required will vary with conditions, and increase with current.

***Strategy Implementation***

Deploy approximately 900 feet of boom inside Pretty Marsh Harbor to protect marsh. Current is too strong under stone culvert at road to boom there. If possible, protect Birch Cove with 1300' of harbor boom from Birch Island to both sides of the cove. Deploy additional 1200' of boom across Bartlett Landing outside of the pilings.

*Site Access* Bartlett Landing is located at the end of Bartlett Landing Road off of Indian Point Road.
