Unless otherwise indicated, the boom length given is straight line distance as measured on the map. Actual length required will vary with conditions, and increase with current.

Strategy Implementation

Deploy 3,800' of harbor boom from northwest side of Wilbur Island to point of land northwest on Leighton Neck. Deploy 2,400' of harbor boom between two points of land at the mouth of Hardscrabble and Dennys Rivers in a "U" configuration to use as a recovery strategy.
