Strategy Implementation	<p>Use extreme caution deploying this strategy. Strong currents and confused seas. Deploy 600' section of harbor boom from Race Point to west side of Coffin Neck; deploy one 1,000 foot section and one 500 foot section of harbor boom from east side of Coffins Neck to west side of Huckins Island; deploy 600' section of harbor boom from east side of Huckins Island to small adjacent point on Denbow Neck.</p>
